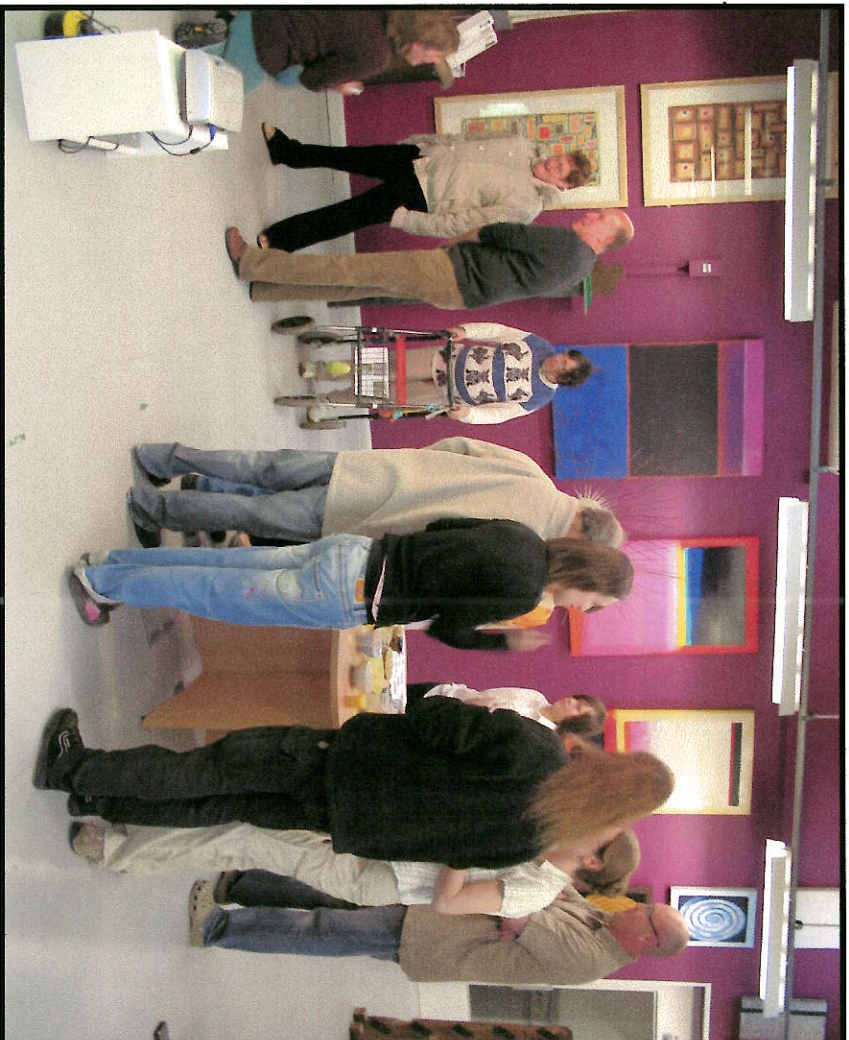

Volunteers.

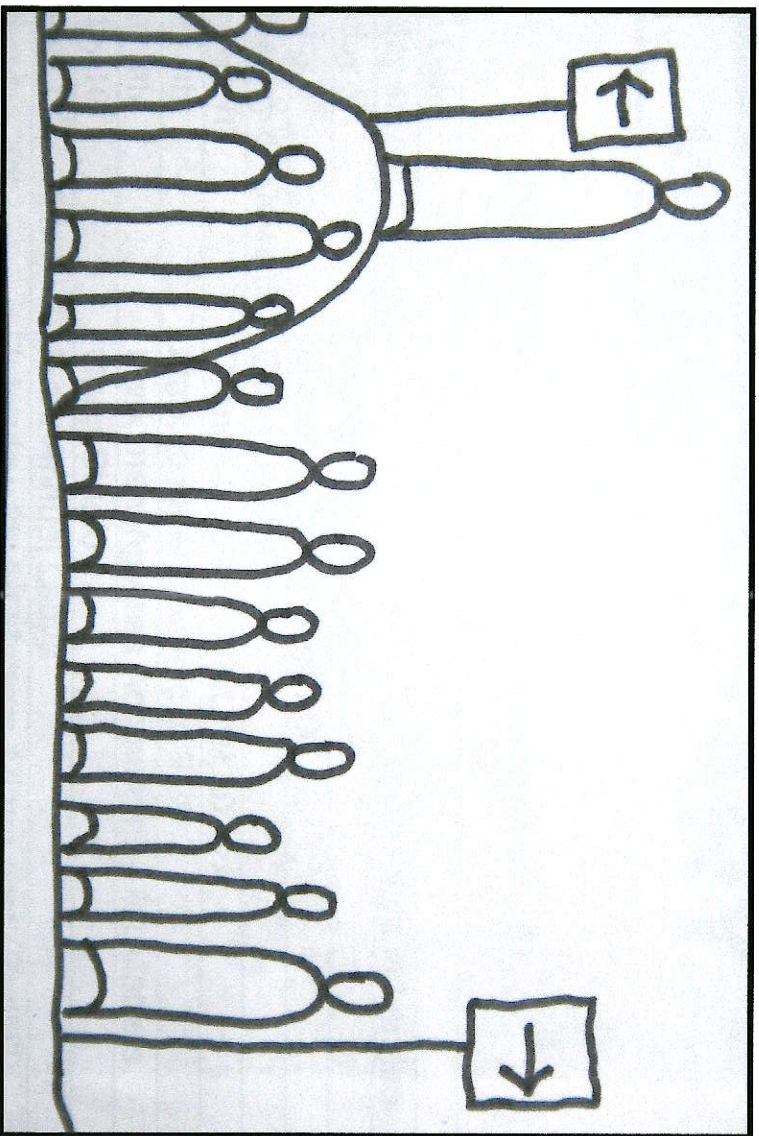
