Surrey Sculpture held an exhibition of work at Pfizer during the summer. The society raised £411-00 through sales that they wised to go to a good cause.

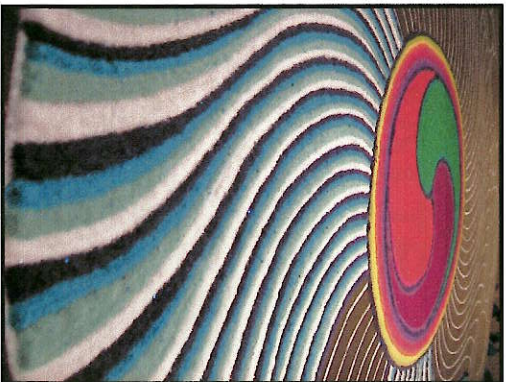

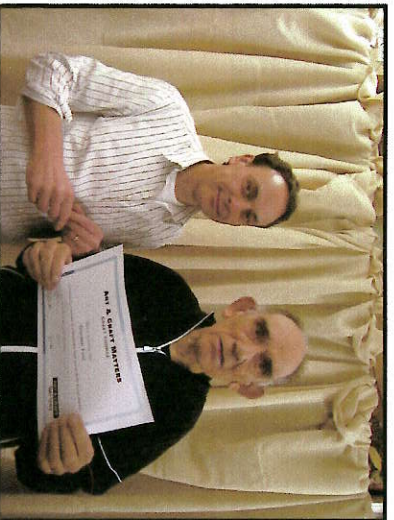
**World Mental Health Day
